NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- Exhibitors should follow their doctor's advice on attending the shows if they are in a high-risk group for COVID-19.
- Fairgrounds will not be available until Thursday at 3:00 P.M.. The gate will close at 10:00 pm every night except Sunday. On Sunday, the gate will close one hour after the conclusion of BIS.
- Fairgrounds gate will open each morning of the shows at 6:00 am.
- Ringside crating will be available in designated areas only. The area will be available 15 minutes before and after your breed is being judged. Please be mindful of other exhibitors and please adhere to the 15-minute rule.
- Crate fans are allowed for dogs but must be attached to the crate.
- Please stack crates for small and medium sized dogs. You may be directed to do so by Site Control so please come prepared with boards and anything else you may need to stack crates.
- Cooperation with all club members, Event Committee members, RV parking personnel and Brooklyn Fairgrounds Security is mandatory. Following instructions and directions is required at all times. Using rude, abusive, or foul language, or arguing or behaving objectionably against club officials, RV parking personnel or Brooklyn Fairgrounds Security will result in that attendee being immediately subject to an Event Committee Hearing and/or being removed from the grounds. THERE WILL BE NO EXCEPTIONS!
- No extended Flex Leads allowed on show grounds.
- When possible please leave strollers outside. Do not bring them under the tents or in any buildings.
- No practicing in the rings at any time.

Please be aware that these shows will follow all CDC, local, regional and federal guidelines regarding COVID-19 prevention that are in place at the time of the shows. You are expected to follow all guidelines as well as any posted signs and verbal instructions from the members of the St. Hubert and Windham County Kennel Clubs and all AKC Specialty Clubs holding cluster events, as well as all Brooklyn Agricultural Society staff. Anyone not following instructions will be subject to Event Hearing Committee proceedings.

Daily Parking

Daily Parking is \$5.00 and will be collected upon entrance to the grounds.

RV Parking and Prime Parking

No cones or markers are to be used in the parking areas. Overnight RV parking on the show grounds **by reservation is \$40.00 each day** per vehicle. A limited number of electricity hookups are available to those with reservations.

Overnight RV parking with no reservation is \$50.00 cash each day per vehicle. A dump station is available on the grounds. Reservations must be made with Penny Kretchmer (**see form below).

Gate will be open Thursday from 3:00 P.M. to 10:00 P.M. for RVs and will reopen at 6:00 A.M. Friday.

There will be a limited number of Prime Parking spaces by the rings for vehicles available by reservation. This allows exhibitors to leave equipment overnight. Cost is **\$20.00** per day with reservations. Prime Parking without reservations will be **\$25.00** cash per day. Electricity is available to ONLY THOSE WITH ADVANCE RESERVATIONS at the cost of **\$10.00** per day. Electricial hookups are limited for all reserved parking.

This is a recorded event by the AKC for the Certificate of Merit and Puppy of Achievement certificates. Section 1 - Classifications

The Four-to-Six Month Puppy competition shall be for dogs that are four months of age and over, but under six months on the first day of the event. Classes will be offered for breed and varieties and divided into Groups as described in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows and the Miscellaneous Class breeds as listed in Chapter 3, Section 23. The Miscellaneous class competition will be the equivalent of Group competition and the winner will be eligible to compete in Best Four-to-Six Month Puppy in Show. The FSS competition will be the equivalent of Group competition and the winner will be eligible to compete in Best Four-to-Six Month Puppy in Show.

AKC National Owner-Handled Series

The AKC National Owner-Handled Series is a non-titling competition for dogs that are exhibited by their owners that are not professional handlers.

Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner-Handled eligible at the time of entry on the entry form.

Dogs entered in the Amateur-Owner-Handler class will automatically be marked as eligible to compete in the NOHS.

Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the judge's book, steward's book & the catalog. Dogs must be handled throughout the breed level competition for the regular show by an eligible owner.

Current assistants that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age & amateur status requirements) may participate in NOHS.

FROM THE NORTH: Follow the Mass Pike (I-90) West to Exit 10 (intersection with I-290/I-395). Travel South on I-395 into CT. Continue South on I-395 for approximately 16 miles. Take Exit 37B onto Route 6 West. Travel West on Route 6 for approximately 4 miles to the intersection of Route 169 in Brooklyn. Turn left onto Route 169 South. Fairgrounds is 1/2 mile ahead.

FROM THE WEST: Travel East on I-84 to I-384 East. I-384 becomes Route 6 in Bolton. Travel East on Route 6 for roughly 40 minutes until reaching the intersection with Route 169 in Brooklyn. Turn right onto Route 169 South. Fairgrounds is 1/2 mile ahead.

FROM THE EAST: Travel West on Route 6 into CT. Continue West on Route 6 for approximately 7 miles to the intersection with Route 169. Turn left onto Route 169 South. Fairgrounds is ½ mile ahead.

FROM THE SOUTH: Travel North on I-395 to Exit 91. Take Exit 37 onto Route 6 West. Travel West on Route 6 for approximately 4 miles to the intersection of Route 169 in Brooklyn. Turn left on Route 169 South. Fairgrounds is 1/2 mile ahead.





The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.

3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e, age division, color division, weight division.

4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name.
